1.) ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK: The undersigned acknowledges that activity related to livestock, rodeo, trail riding, and horsemanship events are dangerous activities and that participation in rodeo training activities and other related activities expose the participant to a substantial and serious risk of property damage, personal injury, and even death. Notwithstanding the risk involved, the undersigned expressly consents to the participant assuming such risk.

2.) RELEASE OF SPONSORS AND OTHERS: The undersigned being fully aware of the above mentioned risk releases and forever discharges the RODEO BIBLE CAMP COMMITTEE, CLARK COUNTY CHAPTER OF FELLOWSHIP OF CHRISTIAN COWBOYS, and the CLARK COUNTY SADDLE CLUB, their respective officers, directors, agents, staff, successors and assignees and anyone acting on their behalf, from any and all damages, costs, losses, claims, actions or causes of action of every kind and nature, whether past, present or future, arising out of or in any way connected with the participant's participation in or attendance of RODEO BIBLE CAMP.

**MINOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND
INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

I/WE HEREBY RELEASE, WAVE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND DISCHARGE the promoter, participants, rodeo association, sanctioning organization or any subdivision thereof, arena operator, arena owner, officials, other participants, any persons in restricted area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners, lessees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers and employees, all for the purpose therein referred to as "Releases" from liability to the undersigned, my/our personal representatives assigns, heirs and next of kin for any and all loss or damage and any claim or any demand on account of any injury to the participant included, but not limited to death whether caused by the negligence of the "Releases", or otherwise while the minor is in or upon the restricted area and/or competing, officiating in, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in the event.

The Restricted Area is defined as the arena, chutes, staging areas, approaches thereto and all walkways, concessions and other areas appurtenant to any such area where any activity related to the event shall take place.

I/we will inform and instruct the said minor participant that upon entering any restricted area the minor must continuously thereafter inspect such restricted area and all portions thereof which the minor enter and with which he comes in contact and I/we further warrant that the minor's entry upon such restricted area or areas and his participation, if any in the event constitutes an acknowledgment that he, (minor), has inspected such restricted area and that he finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of his use, he further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, he is in or about restricted areas and if he feels anything is unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted areas.

The undersigned expressly acknowledge and agree that the activities of the event are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.

Each of the undersigned parents or legal guardians for the minor participant agrees to indemnify and save and hold harmless the "Releases", and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur due to the presence of the said minor in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing or working for any purpose participating in the event and caused by the negligence of the "Releases" or otherwise.
