We hope to see you at camp this year! Camper schedule includes Bible classes, special speakers, small group Bible studies, singing, good food, and rodeo activities. All campers are required to attend all scheduled events. CCFCC is a Bible based ministry, organized for the purpose of introducing teenagers to Jesus Christ our Lord, to strengthen the faith of those already born again, to instruct in basic rodeo skills, and to give teens the opportunity to put their skills into practice by actual rodeo competition. - 1. Violations of this policy may result in a camper not being allowed to compete in a rodeo event, may disqualify them from receiving awards, and /or being dismissed from camp. ALL discipline decisions by the Camp Director are final.
- 2. Campers are permitted to leave the grounds ONLY with the permission of the Camp Director.
- 3. Campers are expected to be prompt at all meals and meetings unless excused by the Camp Director.
- 4. Campers are required to attend all scheduled activities.
- 5. Boys are not permitted in the area of the girl's sleeping quarters and girls are not permitted in the area of the boy's sleeping quarters.
- 6. The bucking machine is under the supervision of the Camp Director and whomever he assigns, and may be used only when one of them is running the controls. Girls are not allowed to ride rough stock or Mighty Bucky.
- 7. Every camper is responsible for his/her own personal belongings and money.
- 8. Any camper defacing camp property must pay for the damages incurred.
- 9. Campers are required to stay in their sleeping quarters from the time of "lights out" until morning rising, except for emergencies.
- 10. It is expected that everyone will dress in a manner which is pleasing to God and does not draw unnecessary attention. Dress code will be enforced from the time of registration until after the awards ceremony and is as follows: Shorts will be allowed during free time. (Ladies, shorts that are too short will not be allowed.) No tank tops. Shirts must be long enough to cover the belt loops on your pants. Full western attire is required while competing: long sleeved shirt, belt, jeans, western boots, and western hat.
- 11. Campers are not permitted to bring Electronic devices. If cell phones are brought, they will be turned in during registration and returned on last day of camp.
- 12. We encourage Christ-honoring relationships between boys and girls. Campers are not allowed to engage in intimate physical contact. Including, but not limited to, holding hands, kissing, and hugging.
- 13. Any case of illness, injury or infection must be reported at once. Failure to do so may jeopardize any claim for insurance.
- 14. No Alcohol, Tobacco, Illegal drugs, or Swearing.
- 15. Campers who are <u>not</u> rough stock riders are not allowed to be behind the chutes during the rodeos.
- 16. When campers are not competing at the rodeos, they are expected to be watching and supporting fellow campers as they compete.

CAMP REMINDERS

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Bible
- Personal care items (soap, towel, etc.) -Clean clothes (including long sleeve shirts, and jeans for rodeos) Medication to be turned into camp Nurse.
- Western boots, hats, and rain gear
- Horse, saddle, and necessary gear
- Hay, or other feed and water bucket
- Rodeo gear (if you have any)
- Stall cleaning equipment
- Bedroll, sleeping, pad, and pillow
- Bathing suit to shower in

PLEASE NOTE

- No Dogs
- No cell phones, music players, other electronics
- Campers must attend all activities
- No Alcohol, Tobacco, or Drugs
- Long sleeve shirts, jeans, western shirts, cowboy boots and hats must be worn while competing in the arena. Boots with heal must be worn around livestock or when riding at all times.
- Shorts ok during free time. (Ladies, no short shorts.) No tank tops. Tops must come below belt loops on pants.
- Clearly marked all your belongings with your name
- No mares with foal at side will be allowed
- Family members are not allowed on camp grounds except during rodeos or with permission from camp director.

Stall Procedures: Please Read Carefully

- 1. We will have a stall supervisor/ watchman you need to check in and out with. If you cannot find anyone or have questions or problems, see someone at the main camp office.
- 2. Please <u>do not</u> put your horses in a stall or set up pens until you have checked in with supervisor and registered.
- 3. On your stall card there will be a daily check of whether or not your stall has passed inspection. Be sure to clean your stall daily.
